The above horse was examined at Bimbadeen Park on July 29th 2020. The filly was bright and alert, and physical examination including cardiac and lung auscultation was unremarkable. No limb swelling or effusion was present. Hoof tester response was negative, and no lameness was seen at a walk or a trot. Laryngeal palpation was unremarkable and clinical eye examination was within normal limits. I did not find any reason that would preclude this horse from being syndicated and raced.

I have not examined this horse previously and have no financial interest in the animal.

VETERINARY EXAMINATION FOR DYNAMIC SYNDICATIONS

At the request of Dynamic Syndications, a pre-sale veterinary examination of **Lot 469, SAVABEEL ex BINGO, 2018 brown yearling filly**, brands as described in the 2020 New Zealand Bloodstock Book 1 Yearling Sales Catalogue, was carried out at the Karaka Sales Complex, Karaka, Auckland, NZ, on 26 January 2020, prior to the commencement of the NZ Bloodstock sale.

Clinical Examination:

She was very well conformed, nicely balanced individual, athletic, with good bone, girth and rein. She was presented in excellent condition. She is a high-quality yearling standing over good ground and walked with a good action. The filly is still immature and will develop further. All clinical parameters were found to be within normal limits. She was examined in hand, and was found to be free moving. Heart auscultation was normal. There was no clinical evidence of wear or injury to her extremities.

Radiographic Examination:

Pre-sale there was a full set of radiographs available for inspection in the repository at the NZ Bloodstock sale complex. Upon examination, they were considered **low risk** and there were no radiographic findings of any significance noted.


Endoscopic Examination:

Pre-sale the upper respiratory tract was examined with a video endoscope. Endoscopically the larynx and pharynx were found to be **Grade 1** which represents normal in appearance and function.

Conclusion:

In my opinion, at the time of this examination, **Lot 469, SAVABEEL ex BINGO 2018 brown yearling filly**, is in so far as can be determined from the extensive examination conducted, suitable for racing and public syndication and as such, is therefore suitable for all risk mortality insurance cover. I confirm that I advised Dynamic Syndications that in my opinion this lot was suitable for purchase.
