VETERINARY EXAMINATION FOR DYNAMIC SYNDICATIONS

At the request of Dynamic Syndications our practice was asked to re-examine the **MAGNA GRECIA (IRE) x BLUE MONEY, 2021 Bay yearling filly,** brands described as **Capital C** nr sh., **130 over 1** off sh., to assess its continued suitability for public syndication. The purpose of the re-examination request was for the promoter to meet ongoing compliance with regulatory requirements by supplying a current veterinary certificate for inclusion with their PDS.

The horse had previously been inspected on behalf of Dynamic Syndications at Coolmore Stud, Jerrys Plains, NSW, on the 23rd May 2022, where a detailed pre-purchase inspection was conducted including a full set of x-rays being read which were considered **low risk**, and an endoscopic evaluation was conducted which was **Grade 1** (**low risk**). My client was advised at the time; the filly was suitable for their purchase.

Clinical Examination:

This re-examination was performed on the 25th November 2022 at Bimbadeen Park, Werombi, NSW, where the filly has been located since arriving from Gooree Park. This was a general health check which included: temperature, pulse, respiration, thoracic auscultation, as well as an ophthalmological examination for eyesight, mucous membrane colour, musculature symmetry and basic conformation, where no abnormalities were found.

There was no lameness at the walk and trot in hand. No response to hoof testers was found. On palpation and manipulation of the distal limbs including major joints, no abnormalities were found. The filly has a quiet temperament.

The filly remains a free moving, quality individual. She is well balanced, well conformed, with good bone and overall strength. She possesses a typical sprinter style, short-coupled, conformation. The filly as expected is still quite immature and will develop further. All clinical parameters were found to be within normal limits. No radiographs, blood tests, drug sampling, ECG or upper respiratory endoscope were performed.

Conclusion:

In my opinion as at the **25th NOVEMBER 2022**, the date of re-examination, the **MAGNA GRECIA (IRE) ex BLUE MONEY**, **2021 Bay yearling filly**, so far as can be determined from the examination conducted, presents in good health and has passed clinical examination and remains suitable for all risk mortality insurance cover and is suitable for racing and public syndication.

VETERINARY EXAMINATION FOR DYNAMIC SYNDICATIONS

At the request of Dynamic Syndications, a pre-sale veterinary examination was conducted on **Lot 210**, **MAGNA GRECIA (IRE) ex BLUE MONEY**, **2021 Bay Weanling Filly**, brands: capital **C** nr shoulder, **130** over **1** off shoulder, as described in the 2022 Inglis May (Late) Online Auction Sale Catalogue. This inspection was conducted at Coolmore Stud, Jerry's Plains NSW, on the 23rd May 2022, prior to the Sale.

Clinical Examination:

The filly presented as a high-quality individual, in excellent condition. Well conformed, athletic, short-coupled sprinter type, with good scope, a deep girth, and moves well. The filly is still immature and will develop significantly further. All clinical parameters were found to be within normal limits. She was examined in hand and was found to be free moving. Stethoscope examination of heartbeat was normal. There was no clinical evidence of wear or injury to extremities.

Radiographic Examination:

Pre-sale there was a full set of radiographs available for inspection. Upon examination, they were considered **low risk** as there were no radiographic findings of any significance noted.

Endoscopic Examination:

Post-sale, for the purchaser, I conducted an upper respiratory tract examination endoscopically. She was passed with the larynx and pharynx found to be rated **Grade 1** (**low risk**) (normal in appearance and function).

Conclusion:

In my opinion, at the time of this examination, Lot 210, MAGNA GRECIA (IRE) ex BLUE MONEY, 2021 Bay Weanling Filly, is in so far as can be determined from the examination conducted, suitable for racing and public syndication and as such, is therefore suitable for all risk mortality insurance cover.

Comment: Rating this horse as a low, moderate or high risk to develop lameness in one

of the radiographed joints or areas I would rate this horse as a **low** risk.

Please be aware that this radiographic series is taken roughly three quarters of the way through a young horse's rapid developmental growth phase. As such various forms of developmental bone disease can still occur - so purchasers are encouraged

to consider survey radiographs in September this year.
