VETERINARY EXAMINATION FOR DYNAMIC SYNDICATIONS

At the request of Dynamic Syndications, I was asked to re-examine the **bay thoroughbred yearling Colt** by **FARNAN** out of **HUBOOR (IRE) 2024** to assess its continued suitability for public syndication. The purpose of the request was for the promoter to meet ongoing compliance with regulatory requirements by supplying a current veterinary certificate for inclusion with their PDS.

The colt had previously been inspected on behalf of my client Dynamic Syndications at the Magic Millions Yearling Sale, Bundall, Queensland, on the **14th January 2026**, prior to the commencement of the Sale, where a detailed pre-purchase inspection was conducted including a full set of x-rays being read and were considered **Low Risk**, and an endoscopic evaluation conducted which was **Grade 2 Lane** (normal). I advised my client in my opinion the colt was suitable for purchase.

Identification:

Near Shoulder: **M 3 OVER SCROLL**
Off Shoulder: **26 over 4**

Clinical Examination:

This examination was conducted on **2nd July 2026** at Bimbadeen Park, Werombi, NSW. The colt was in pre-training for 3 days, having been spelling for 6 weeks. This inspection was a general health check which included temperature, pulse, respiration, thoracic auscultation, as well as an ophthalmological examination for eyesight, mucous membrane colour, musculature symmetry and conformation, where no abnormalities were found.

There was no lameness at the walk and trot in hand. No response to hoof testers was found. On palpation and manipulation of the distal limbs including major joints, no abnormalities were found. The colt has a quiet temperament. His genitalia was considered normal including two palpable descended testicles. No radiographs, blood tests, drug sampling, ECG or upper respiratory endoscope were performed. All clinical parameters were found to be within normal limits.

The colt remains a high-quality individual, strong, athletic and free moving. He is well conformed and well balanced. The colt has grown significantly since his purchase however is still immature and will develop further.

Conclusion:

In my opinion as at the **2nd JULY 2026**, the date of re-examination, the **FARNAN x HUBOOR (IRE) Bay Yearling Colt**, in so far as can be determined from the examination conducted, presents in good health and has passed clinical examination and remains suitable for all risk mortality insurance cover and is suitable for racing and public syndication.

Clinical Examination:

The colt was presented in excellent clinical health, with even muscle mass and well conformed. He was a well-developed, athletic colt. Upon examination all clinical parameters were found to be within normal limits. Ophthalmic examination determined no issues of concern. Auscultation of the thorax (chest) revealed a normal and regular heart rhythm at rest, with the colt having normal lungs sounds and normal respiratory rate at rest. At the time of this examination there were no issues of concern regarding his extremities. His genitalia was considered normal and both testicals have descended.

Repository:

The radiographic and pre scale upper airway endoscopy examinations pertaining to this horse lodged in the repository at the Magic Millions Bundall complex were examined and the findings were as follows:

Radiographs: Low Risk.

Upper Airway Examination: Normal anatomy with Grade 2 function (Lane).

Conclusion:

In my opinion, at the time and within the limits of this examination the thoroughbred **Colt** by **FARNAN** out of **HUBOOR (IRE) 2024** in so far as can be determined within the scope of this examination, is suitable for syndication and all risk mortality insurance cover.
